Accepted to World's Leading Universities

It has been an exciting season with one of the graduates heading to Northwestern University—ranked 11th in the U.S. and 28th in the world (U.S. News, QS). Other graduates were blessed with generous scholarship offers, including one who received JPY5.75 million per year from a top-50 U.S. university, which is enough to cover the full tuition and half of room and board, and another who received JPY3.2 million per year. In addition, one of the graduates is going to a university in Indonesia.

Admission to Ritsumei, Keio, and Sophia without Kōnin

Two of our Year 2017-18 graduates have proceeded to Ritsumeikan University to study information science and international relations. Another student, who aspires to be a journalist, was accepted to Sophia University (Humanities) but decided to go to Keio University (Policy Management), where one of our past graduates is studying. Other graduates have chosen varied paths; one is at Osaka Institute of Technology, another at Sophia University Junior College (English), and two are at language schools, studying Korean and Japanese. Two of our graduates are studying in the KIU Foundations Program (KIU-FP).

Many Academy and KIU-FP Alumni at Graduate Schools

Our alumni have been active in postgraduate programs as well. One of them is at Kyoto University graduate school, the fourth from KIUA, and researching seismology. Two others are going off to law schools in the U.S., one in New York and the other in California. Other students are working on their master's degrees: engineering at Technion-Israel Institute of Technology (ranked 224th in the world, QS), nursing at Rush University (18th best master's program in nursing in the U.S., U. S. News), accounting at Vanderbilt University (the best master's program in accounting in the U.S., TFE), and veterinary at Washington State University (14th best master's program in veterinary in the U.S., TFE). In addition, one of our KIU-FP (University) alumni has just received a master's degree in architecture at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
